For Single-Family Unattached Primary Residences Only

- Recent Utility Bill (Must be in your name and match the listed property address)

Next Step: Schedule Your Exam

Once your application has been reviewed and approved, the next step is to schedule your Homeowner's General Wiring Permit Exam by calling (845) 364-3904. The exam is based on the 2020 National Electrical Code (NEC) and includes one wiring diagram. It is a closed-book test, and the use of calculators, scrap paper, cell phones, or other electronic devices is strictly prohibited. You must bring a valid driver's license for identification. A passing score is 70%, and if you do not pass on your first attempt, you may retake the exam for a \$75 re-test fee. ID Required: Bring a valid driver's license

Important Note:

Scope of Permit

This permit covers minor electrical renovations inside your existing home, limited to:

- 1-2 rooms only
- Switches, lighting, receptacles, and home runs back to the panel

This permit does NOT cover:

- New construction
- Pools
- Underground or overhead electrical services
- Generators
- Solar systems

Homeowners may perform the wiring but **cannot connect to the electrical panel** — this must be done by a **licensed Master Electrician**.

Applicant Certification

I hereby apply for a Homeowner General Wiring Permit in accordance with the provisions outlined above. I certify that I am the legal homeowner of the referenced single-family unattached residence, and that this property is my primary residence. I have read and understand the instructions and scope of work permitted under this application.
